- Each year, 1.5 million Americans sustain a TBI, according to the <u>CDC</u>.
- Motor vehicle crashes are the leading cause of TBI resulting in hospitalization, followed by violence (such as assaults involving firearms), with accidental falls coming in third (the leading cause of TBI in the elderly).
- 5.3 million Americans live with a TBI-related disability.

Calculating the Financial Cost

Because TBI disabilities are not readily apparent to the public (compared with a broken leg, for instance), TBI is known as the invisible epidemic. Resulting disabilities can arise from cognitive, emotional, sensory and motor impairments, and can permanently alter a person's life, how they work, how they interact socially and how they hold onto family relationships.
